School Uniform Survey Results

- 319 responses, 55.2% in favor of keeping the policy and 44.8% in favor of eliminating policy.
- The next step is to discuss with Student Council to come up with ways/incentives to encourage participation
- Policy will remain in place

Goal Sheets

- To be used for each student for unit of study (For K-5, they will be used for Math and ELA, for Middle School, they will be used for Math, ELA, Science and Social Studies.)
- Different for each grade level
- Pretest- Is there knowledge prior to the lesson?
- End of Unit- Was the goal achieved? What is the student proud of and/or what do they need to work on?
- Parent overview letter will be on the back of the goal to explain the unit
- Writing goals will have a rubric on the back

Mrs. Causi: Are the teachers monitoring the progress of the goal? Yes, for example in Math there are mid-chapter reviews

Reading Level Letters

- Last year the SLT board discussed that the Reading Level Letters were not clear
- Revised for each reading level
- Front will show current independent level strategies on how parent can help child or how child can help himself achieve the next level
- Teacher College Levels will be on the back
- Goals will be based on reading levels (levels determined by Running Records in K-2 and in 3-8 the Scranton Performance Series is used)

SLT Renumeration

- SLT members, including students and community-based organization (CBO) representatives, are eligible to receive an annual remuneration of \$300 for completing 30 hours of service on the SLT and attending a training session.
- Team members may satisfy this training requirement by attending a live training session offered by the District Leadership Team or from the Central Office. • Team members who serve less than 30 hours may request remuneration on a prorata basis (\$10.00 per hour). • Team members who contribute more than 30 hours will not receive more than the \$300 allotment. • CBO Members must be listed as a member in the team's bylaws. Individual team members may choose whether to accept or waive the annual
